

On October 3, a body was reported to be floating at Deer Island. Almost 2 weeks later, The BPD and Harrison County Coroners office is asking for the public's assistance

Currently the Biloxi Police Department and the Harrison County's Coroner's Office is asking for the public's assistance with identifying the individual. He is described as a W/M potentially between the ages of 30 and 45 and is approximately 5'10" to 6'02". He weighed approximately 220 to 250 lbs and had short dark hair. He was not wearing specific clothing that can be described. He had several tattoos which included a scorpion on his right shoulder blade, a Viking on his left shoulder blade, Brendan on the back of his right arm and his right inner forearm had two separate tattoos which were an elephant and a clown face with the words "cry now". On his left inner arm he had another clown face with the words "laugh later". He has a tribal tattoo on the left upper arm. On his chest was a tattoo of a ribbon with "11-12-11". The name "Davianna" was tattooed along his left side. He also had some symbols of an unknown language tattooed on his left calf.
