in Gulf  
The Harrison County  
Sheriff's Office has requested  
that a pathologist  
examine "a very  
badly decomposed"  
human body to determine  
Its sex and age.  
The body was found  
Sunday at Chandeleur  
Island.  
According to Sheriff  
Howard L. Hobbs, the  
body was found by fishermen  
and brought to  
Harrison County authorities.  
It was described as  
having no head or legs.  
The body was taken to  
Lang Funeral Home  
where a preliminary examination  
was made by  
Coroner Gladys O'Neil.  
The examination did not  
show sex or age.  
The Sheriff's office  
said checks are being  
made to determine if  
any person is missing in  
water accidents.
