FBI search for children continues

Investigators are still searching for two Edgard three-yearolds who disappeared at a Mother's Day gathering 60 miles north of Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

The two children, Lamoine "Moine" Allen and Kreneice Jones, whose families are friends but not related, were last seen about 4:00 p.m. at Jimmy Jackson's grocery story about four miles east of Woodville, Mississippi. It is speculated that the children were abducted; however, no one saw anyone take the children. The kids were at the grocery story playing when they came up missing.

Woodville is a town of about 1,800 people just across the state line from West Feliciana Parish.

Lamoine was there with relatives with whom he lives in Edgard. His parents, Terrell Allen and Levette Holmes, live out of town. Kreneice was there with her mother, Carla Burke.

In addition to searching Mississippi and Louisiana, deputies and FBI agents are interviewing family and friends. Posters with pictures of the children have been distributed throughout the area.

Both children are black.

Kreneice is three feet tall, weighs 33 pounds and has black hair and brown eyes. She was last seen wearing a colorful all-in-one short outfit, a black and white polka dot tie, and pink slip-per/sandals.

Lamoine weighs 35 to 40 pounds and has black and brown eyes. He has a small scar on his knee. He was last seen wearing light blue shorts, a tank top and black sandals.
