

Body Of Unidentified White Man Found Near Madison County Road

FLOODS HURT FARM CROPS

Northern Counties Report
Damage Following
Heavy Rains

Flood waters from creeks and small rivers, swollen by rains of ten past few days, were causing heavy damage yesterday to lowland crops

CANTON, Sept. 29.—The body of an unidentified white man was brought to Canton Wednesday morning for examination by the sheriff and a coroner's jury. The body was discovered by a little negro boy under a culvert on the old Highway 51, near Gluckstadt.

The body was badly decomposed, but the jury announced that the deceased was between the age of 35 and 40 years. There were no papers or marks of identification upon the clothing, except \$1.49 in change and a small comb in his pocket.

The man had apparently met his death from blows on the head. The jury's verdict was "death at hands of party unknown."

The remains were buried in the Potters field here.
