Clothing: The body was clothed only in a light peach-colored blouse and blue jeans it was reported with no coat, no shoes and no undergarments.

Dentals: Not available , but she had one missing lower front tooth and her teeth were in poor condition but several fillings were found (possibly from youth).

Details:

An autopsy has disclosed the woman was strangled with a narrow object such as a cord or rope.

It is not yet clear however,that strangulation was the cause of death

The woman could have died of exposure, it was noted since temperatures the night of Jan, 23, were extremely cold. The body was spotted about 7:30am, Jan,24 just east of the Coldwater river bridge,by a southbound truck driver, who subsequently notified authorities.

Dentals are available but no DNA or fingerprints.
