

# Body Of Infant Found Floating Near Coast

PASS CHRISTIAN (AP) — A fisherman Saturday found the body of an unidentified infant floating face down in a bayou north of here, the Harrison County sheriff's department said.

Officials said the baby boy was about 20 inches long and appeared well developed. Further information about the child and its death could not be determined and an autopsy is planned Monday, authorities said.

The fisherman spotted the child's body about 10 a.m. floating near the marshes at the edge of the bayou.

## **Infant's body found floating in bayou**

In a third case, Sheriff's Chief Investigator Larkin Smith said Monday authorities are awaiting a report of a pathologist seeking to determine the cause of death of an infant male found floating in a bayou north of Pass Christian.

Smith said the discovery was made Saturday by a fisherman passing in a boat.
