

## MAN KILLED BY THE SOUTHERNER

PICAYUNE — Authorities today were still trying to identify the body of a man killed by the south-bound "Southerner" near Nicholson about 7:30 p. m. Wednesday.

Only clue to the man's identity is the name E. Jensen stenciled in his trouser pock. He appeared to be about 60 years old.

Engineer W. D. Guy said that he saw a man with his head and shoulders on the rail but was unable to stop the train in time to avoid hitting him, according to Weston Lott, Pearl River County Coroner.

The body was taken to McDonald's funeral home in Picayune.
