

Load Of Slag Yields Body Of Infant

CLARKSDALE — The body of a premature, Caucasian, male infant, found Tuesday in a carload of slag a mile from here, was buried the same day in the Shufordsville Cemetery.

Only Dr. F. K. Horton, pastor of the Oakhurst Baptist Church, and George O'Rear of the National Funeral Home were present at the graveside service. Coahoma County paid for the funeral.

when they began strewing the slag along the railroad track. The infant, wrapped in a cloth and stuffed into a paper bag, appeared to have been dead several days, however, the car had been in Clarksdale for two weeks.

An autopsy showed the infant had been born about two or three months premature. Police investigation of the case continues.
