Family seeks public's help in finding missing man

The family of a former Jones County resident is asking for the public's help in locating him.

Roland Earl Plymale, who would have turned 58 years old on May 9th, has been reported missing by his family.

Barbara Watts, Plymale's sister, said she needs to locate her brother, who was last seen on Sept. 2, 2008.

Plymale, originally from Soso, reportedly worked for the Jones County Sheriff's Department several years ago. He later moved to Smith County and was reportedly staying in Forest in Scott County at the time of his disappearance.

Watts, of Arkansas, is in town this week searching for answers.

"I need to know what happened to my brother," she said.

Watts said she has been in contact with the Smith County Sheriff's Department, officials with the Scott County Sheriff's Department, and the Newton County Sheriff's Department.
