

The missing cases with very little information are some of the most distressing. A family in Mississippi (and beyond) are still searching for answers 12 years after 21-year-old Mercedes Jordan disappeared without a trace. The young woman left behind a baby son who has grown up not knowing what happened to his mother. He, along with the rest of Mercedes's loved ones, deserve answers.

The last sighting of Mercedes was on November 7, 2006. She was seen talking with at least one man, described as a black male, near a black car that was inside of her apartment complex. After that, Mercedes was never heard from again.

Her family believes that she was taken against her will.

There is a Facebook Page dedicated to Mercedes, hoping that her case will be shared and there is someone, somewhere, who can shed light on this mysterious situation. There are only to posts on the page, the last of which was written in 2016.

"10 years!!!! It would really be helpful and and a move of God for someone to come forth with any information about her missing or to reveal what they KNOW about her disappearance.. God knows all and it is just a matter of time before he reveals his hand! Ready to help? Raise your hand! We need it! She needs it!"

Mercedes was last seen wearing a white shirt with blue jeans or pink and white striped sweatpants. She also had on a pink jacket and house shoes/slippers. She has large dimples, a scar on her cheek, and an overbite. She stands 5'5" and 185 pounds with brown eyes. Her hair is black and shoulder length, but she often wore it in a ponytail. Her age as of publication is 33-years-old.

There is no other available information released in her case.

Family Seeks Missing Person Meridian, Miss. Chris Brennaman

Merkedes Jordan, 21, went missing in Meridian, Miss., on Nov. 7. She was last seen at the Western Gardens Apartments. Family members say they suspect foul play.

Jordan was seen last Tuesday talking with at least one male near a black vehicle at the apartment complex where she lives. That was the last time anyone knew her exact whereabouts.

Jordan has a one-year-old son who is currently staying with family. The family says it has received some tips but Merkedes' father, Jimmy Peden, says he doesn't believe she is still in the area.

"The latest tip that we do have, she's not here. She's not here in Meridian. The tip that we had before that, she was here in the Meridian area," Peden said.

Peden says he is positive that this is a case of kidnapping and not a runaway. He says in every tip received someone has been with Jordan.
