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Officials seek man's identity

The search for clues to the identity of a man who was killed Friday night east of Pascagoula continued Monday morning.

Coroner Benny Bryant said the accident victim's fingerprints have been sent to the FBI and he expected a report about noon today.

According to the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol, the man, a white man about 50 years old, was killed as he walked across the highway at Kreole Avenue about 9 p.m. Friday.

The death was ruled accidental and no charges were filed against the driver of the car that struck the pedestrian.
